

Caltech Y RISE Program

Information for Tutors

About the Program

The RISE Program is an on-campus afterschool math and science-focused tutoring program serving public schools students. The Caltech Y has been administering the program since 2006 and the program has been successful at helping students who struggle with math and science. The tutoring is serviced by Caltech undergraduate and graduate students. Undergraduate students can use their Federal and Caltech Work-Study allotment to get paid for the tutoring.

Tutoring Schedule: Tutoring is offered 4 days a week from Mondays through Thursdays from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. in Winnett Lounge.

The Role of a Tutor

1. Tutors are asked to commit to a minimum of 2 quarters per year and to 1 or 2 days per week of tutoring.
2. Each session is 2 hours and tutors generally work with the same students. Some students may be temporarily assigned to different tutors due to scheduling or tutors who are unavailable on a particular day.
3. Each tutor's schedule is set per quarter. (Schedule changes each quarter can be accommodated)
4. Tutors are assigned to students according to the scheduling and subjects of interest. Make sure that you will fill out a **Tutor Application Form** and turn it into the Caltech Y so that you can be properly matched with students.

*Your help is always needed even if your schedule changes. As your schedule changes each quarter so will the schedules of other tutors. Things always work out. Tutors' schedule changes end up canceling each other out and the high school students always get a replacement without having to miss a day due to lack of available tutors.
